To celebrate, the Quilts Kingston 2015 challenge is “*Sir John A. / Sir John, Eh?*”

Competition details:

- Entrants must be current members of either the Kingston Heirloom Quilters (KHQ) or the Limestone Quilters’ Guild (LQG);
- Quilt perimeter *not to exceed* 150 inches (e.g., a 3 foot square is 144 inches);
- No minimum size;
- Unlike previous challenge competitions, this year there is no entry fee;
- Entry form (see reverse) to be submitted by **March 4th, 2015**.
